Douglas County: Commissioner Partridge reported on the activities of the Board:

- Lincoln Avenue construction will begin in June with completion in 6 months
- I25 lane balancing work to be soon; there will be traffic delays
- The Public Safety citizen survey showed extremely high satisfaction levels
- June kick-off meeting for a broad based coalition to address gaps in mental health services and focus on youth 10-12

- Numerous bills were supported, opposed or held neutral by CML. Great level of cooperation between organizations on most legislative matters.
- 730 bills introduced this year. CML tracked 231:
 1. Bills that were Successful - 84% supported by CML
 2. Bills that were defeated – 94% opposed by CML
