**RESOLUTION AFFIRMING COLLABORATIVE EFFORTS
BETWEEN DOUGLAS COUNTY GOVERNMENT, THE TOWN
OF CASTLE ROCK, THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, THE CITY OF
LONE TREE, THE TOWN OF PARKER, THE DOUGLAS
COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND THE DOUGLAS PUBLIC
LIBRARY DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the taxpayers and citizens of Douglas County and its municipalities to work together where possible on projects and programs where two or more of the entities have a common interest; and

WHEREAS, collaborative efforts can save money, improve efficiency, and enhance the effectiveness of local government programs and projects; and

WHEREAS, a committee of elected and appointed representatives from Douglas County, the Town of Castle Rock, the Town of Larkspur, the City of Lone Tree, the Douglas County School District, the Douglas Public Library District and the Town of Parker have been meeting to discuss collaborative activities; and

WHEREAS, this committee has identified a significant number of areas where collaborative efforts can prove beneficial to the partner communities.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Partnership of Douglas County Governments supports this effort by providing by providing staff and elected official representatives to the Partnership of Douglas County Governments and by sharing the meeting and facilitation costs of the committee.
- Section 2. The Partnership of Douglas County Governments actively seeks opportunities for collaborative efforts between two or more of the Partnership members.
- Section 3. The Partnership of Douglas County Governments commits to achieve the following: Cost savings to the taxpayers of Douglas County and its municipalities; improvements in operations; and programming efficiency; and enhancement of the level of service currently being provided.
- Section 4. The Partnership of Douglas County Governments promotes communication, cooperation and coordination at all levels of its operations to help identify areas where collaborative efforts between the members of the Partnership will accomplish the goals set forth in Section 3.

Section 5. The Partnership of Douglas County Governments communicates the efforts and successes of the Partnership to its constituents both individually and jointly to let the citizens of Douglas County and its municipalities know the importance and benefits of collaborative efforts.




