Highlands Ranch Metro District: Vicki Starkey reported:

- Received a collaboration award at the SDA Conference because of the PDCG
- Household Chemical Roundup was a great success
- Quick Car, owned by Littleton Fire Department, is a non-transport fully equipped small emergency vehicle for lessor emergencies

Douglas County School District: Thomas Tsai reported:

- 2040 student projections = 120,000; current 67,000
- Significant student increase at all schools

Town of Parker: Debbie Lewis reported:

- Economic Development Department is now located in their new offices
- The Town sponsored a Police Academy for citizen education

- Demo of the old King Soopers site is underway
- Received significant public input on Park Master Planning
- 11 acre Disc Golf Course/Dog Park is located south of E470
- The new bakery is booming

City of Castle Pines: Mayor Jeff Huff reported:

- The 3rd Run Wild event was a great success with over 500 participants
- Have had illegal dumping in the wastewater system – may cause rate increases
- The City will present the State of the City tonight at a Chamber outreach. Over 75 will be in attendance

Douglas County Libraries: Demetria Heath reported:

- Model for interaction with kids autism
- The building campaign is on tract

Douglas County: Commissioner Weaver reported:

- Been engaged in state-wide meetings
- The County population is 303,000
- Want to develop a county-wide think tank for idea development

City of Lone Tree: Kim Monson reported:

- Charles Schwab will open very soon
- Completed the Lone Tree Transportation Link Shuttle dedication
- Art collection was donated for placement in the community

Town of Larkspur: Matt Krimmer reported:

- Karaoke event raised \$1200 for the park
- Autumn harvest had 60 booths and drew an attendance of 1600
- Muck Fest had 2000 participants
- Jellystone Campground has 250,000 lights and characters for Xmas
- Upcoming Firefighters for Cancer Fundraiser

- Recent Election: approved removal of the Town Manager authority on open carry and voted for people to control destiny on open carry
